7 Common Chord Progressions for Every Piano Player

Melody generally uses the notes of a chord or notes that return to it. In order to improvise you need to know and play every chord very well. The fundamental drill is playing every chord and every inversion of each chord. I suggest to study five families of chords:

1. Major 7th chord
2. Dominant 7th
3. Minor 7th
4. Half-diminished
5. Diminished 7th
